RULING

25 The matter was fixed by Court and cause listed. The Applicant seeks for
revocation of the grant of Letters of Administration given to Okee Joseph
and Omona Constantino, since Omona is now deceased, leaving Okee
Joseph as a single administrator. That grant was made by Hon. Justice
Masalu Musene vide Administration Cause No. 071/2010 on 16/3/2011,
and is on record. There is a death certificate proving death of the second
30 Administrator Omona Constantino. He died on 21/8/2011, five months
after being appointed administrator. There is minute of family meeting

5 proposing the surviving administrator – Okee Joseph to be joined by
Obwonyo Okeny as new administrators. I am satisfied that the old grant
had become inoperative due to death of the other administrator, under
S.234(1)(2)(d) of the Succession Act. I accordingly revoke the grant of
16/3/2011, and proceed to appoint Okee Joseph and Obwonyo Okeny as
10 Administrators of the estate of the late Okeny Adimiriki (deceased) for two
years from the date hereof pursuant to Section 234(5) of the Succession
Act. See: **In the matter of the late John Peter Otto, Miscellaneous
Application No. 0149 of 2023 (Okello, J.).** The Administrators shall
lodge an inventory in Court by 11/4/2025, and a final account not later
15 than 11/4/2026. The Letters of Administration so granted expires on
11/4/2026. It is so ordered.
